- o Restaurant Paradis – always a favorite fine dining establishment of locals. Steaks and seafood. Can't go wrong at Paradis. Located on S. Barrett Square.
- o Cowgirl Kitchen – laidback lunch or dinner spot, featuring salads, tacos, and pizza. Great for kids. Located on Main Street.
